PRESENTATIONS

1. Delegation – Concerns regarding draft by-law to regulate and prohibit smoking on municipally owned property in the Town of Petawawa – Mr. Bob King

Mr. Bob King brought forward his concerns regarding the draft by-law to regulate and prohibit smoking on municipally owned property in the Town of Petawawa. Mr. King was concerned that Council is making a decision based on 250 responses to a survey which only represents approximately 2.48% of the population of the Town of Petawawa. Mr. King further noted that out of the 250 responses only 63% of the respondents supported a by-law that would restrict smoking on municipal property while 37% of the respondents did not support such a by-law. Mr. King wants Council to drop the issue and not proceed with the draft by-law if only 2.48% of the Town's population participated in the survey.


