PLANNING

1. Activity Report – September 2013

Karen Cronier, Planning Coordinator, presented her monthly report. Ms. Cronier noted that the Official Plan review will be back before Council in November. Ms.

Cronier provided a verbal update regarding Mr. Cam Bimm's presentation to Council on October 21st. She advised that she and Mitchell Stillman, CAO/Clerk, met via conference call with the Town's Solicitor regarding Mr. Bimm's suggestion to vacate a portion of his building to allow for sufficient parking spaces for his tenants. Ms. Cronier advised that the *Planning Act* does not have provisions for this this type of suggestion. She further noted that Mr. Bimm submitted a minor variance application today to deal with the insufficient number of parking spaces.

2. PL-31-13 – Consent Application B08/13, Doran Road, Ivan Hoffman

Karen Cronier provided an overview of the consent application. Ms. Cronier reported that the purpose and effect of the application is to sever a 9.63 acre parcel of land to be used for a concrete manufacturing plant. The property is designated Mineral Aggregate under the Official Plan and zoned Extractive Industrial (EM). The establishment of a concrete plant is a permitted use. Two letters of objection were received; and correspondence was received from Hydro One and the County of Renfrew.

Discussion took place regarding the amount of traffic on Doran Road and whether the County has looked into this when considering the entrance permit for the property. Mayor Bob Sweet indicated that he would follow up with the County regarding this item. Ms. Cronier further noted that traffic flow can be reviewed during the site plan application process.

Discussion also took place regarding the speed limit on Doran Road within the vicinity of the Doran/Black Bay intersection.

One letter of objection was received from Mr. Chad Brand who was interested in purchasing a portion of the proposed severed lands.
