Rules of Conduct for Public Ice Skating Petawawa Civic Centre

- 1. No food or drink on the ice surface.
- 2. No horseplay or games.
- 3. No figure skating maneuvers.
- 4. No erratic or excessive speeds.
- 5. No balls, pucks, chairs, strollers, sticks or any other items which might interfere with the safety of another skater while on the ice surface.
- 6. No headsets, cell phones or hand held electronic devised are to be used while skating.
- 7. No carrying of children permitted.
- 8. No sitting on the boards.
- 9. Skate with the direction of all skaters.
- 10. Listen and adhere to the skate monitors at all times. All participants must be wearing skates while on the ice surface.
- 11. Consider the use of a helmet as they are strongly recommended.
