Petawawa, ON – The Town of Petawawa is issuing temporary restrictions on non-essential water use. These restrictions are in response to the continued hot temperatures, lack of rainfall and the increase in personal consumption.

To ensure that consumption demands of all residents can be met, the following restrictions shall apply until further notice:

OUTDOOR WATERING (LAWNS, GARDENS ETC.):

- **WATERING IS ALLOWED ONLY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 6:00 A.M. AND 9:00 A.M. Watering in the evening is NOT permitted at this time.**
- Residents occupying an **even numbered address** may water on **even numbered calendar days** only (e.g. 2,4,6).
- Residents occupying an **odd numbered address** may water on **odd numbered calendar days** only (e.g. 1,3,5).

The Town of Petawawa wishes to thank residents for their patience and adherence to the temporary watering restrictions. Further restrictions, including a total ban on non-essential use, may be introduced if required.

Water conservation and proper management will ensure that residents continue to receive essential services until weather conditions improve.
