Subject:	<u>Vaccination Screening Requirements</u>

The recent implementation of COVID-19 vaccination requirements for Petawawa Civic Centre and Norman Behnke Hall facility users includes a number of exemptions within the Provincial regulations governing the requirement. Many of these exemptions are focused within minor sports activities including the exemption of team officials (coaches, trainers, managers, equipment personnel) and game officials (including scorekeepers).

In order to streamline the vaccination screening process as well as provide staff and facility users with increased levels of vaccine security, the Town of Petawawa will require, effective October 1st, 2021, that all youth sport coaches, officials, volunteers (who are working in the facility), scorekeepers etc. be fully vaccinated (2 doses plus 14 days) in order to enter the above-noted facilities. Medical exemptions in the appropriate format will still apply.

It should also be noted that many sport governing organizations are currently adopting their own specific COVID-19 screening policies and procedures. All sport groups and associations using Town of Petawawa facilities should ensure that they are aware of these additional requirements, if applicable.
