1. Monthly Report – June 2022

Daniel Scissons, CAO, provided an overview of the monthly report. Mr. Scissons highlighted capital projects to-date and commented on initiatives that are underway, including Airport Road, Len Hopkins Drive, Kin Hut Parking Lot and Volunteer Way, Renfrew Street Pumping Station, and culvert replacements on Pitzner Road and Eichstaedt Road. Mr. Scissons reported the second public meeting for the Petawawa Net Zero Project is scheduled for July 11, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. Mr. Scissons also reported under energy management the successful completion of the annual Conservation and Demand Management Plan and the Green House Gas reports.
