The incumbents are to act as a leader and work alongside Town staff. The incumbents will be responsible for kayak, canoe and stand up paddle board lesson and rental programs as well as providing general customer service to Petawawa Point Park users.

Responsibilities:

- Organize, maintain and oversee the canoe, kayak and stand up paddle board rental and lesson programs
- Active involvement in the operation and delivery of recreation programs and/or events
- Ensure facility and beachfront are safe and clean on a daily basis
- Prepare lists and tracking attendance (sign in/sign out sheets)
- Ensure rental programs and lessons run on schedule and all required supplies are in working order
- Review, complete and follow up on incident reports and report to Recreation Program Coordinator
- Assist Town of Petawawa staff with summer day camp programs
- Other duties as assigned
