Description:

- Implementation and involvement in all aspects of summer camp programs
- Supervise participants with guidance from Summer Camp Director, Recreation Program Coordinator and Recreation Program Assistant
- Assist with responding to parent questions and concerns to ensure customer satisfaction
- Ensure programs are run safely and on schedule
- Learn and teach assigned camp curriculum and weekly camp programs
- Other duties as assigned
