Off-Road Vehicles are permitted to travel on established designated routes within the Corporation of the Town of Petawawa. These routes are identified as:

*Black Bay Road, from Petawawa Boulevard westerly to Highway 17, and vice versa; and *All Town of Petawawa municipal roads west of Highway 17 (Priebe, Rantz, Black Bay, Eichstaedt etc.).

Further, Off-Road Vehicles are permitted to cross Petawawa Boulevard (CR-51) from the Algonquin Trail to access core services at the following five (5) designated intersections: *Doran Road/Petawawa Boulevard/Mohns Avenue;

*Murphy Road/Petawawa Boulevard/Civic Centre Road;


*Canadian Forces Drive/Petawawa Boulevard;

*Town Centre Boulevard/Petawawa Boulevard/Limestone Trail; and

*Black Bay Road/Petawawa Boulevard/Gutzman Road.




