Economic Development

Public Works

Monthly Report – September 2024

Chris Mantha, Director of Public Works, provided an overview of the report. Mr. Mantha reported on the status of the Public Works Office expansion, the Comfort Station, and the Wolfe Avenue, Portage Road, and Murphy Road construction projects. Mr. Mantha also reported on the status of the department's infrastructure priorities such as the Town's fleet procurement, the arrival of the new electric vehicle, the Net Zero Project, and that 2025 budget planning has begun.
