

# 2025 Tax Bulletin

### **Understanding the Property Tax Cycle**

The Town has three tax due dates, however we only send you two notices. Tax bills run a fiscal year from January 1st to December 31st.

#### **Interim Tax Bill**

The Town issues an Interim Tax Bill for all properties with one installment due the at the end of March. Properties with a mortgage company listed on the tax account will not receive a copy of the Interim Tax Bill.

Your Interim Tax Bill is calculated at 50% of your previous year taxes levied minus special charges (residential garbage/water/sewer) to get the tax year started.

#### Final Tax Bill

The Town issues a Final Tax Bill for the residential, farm, managed forest tax and pipeline classes with two installments – installments are due the second last business day of **July** and **October**, respectively.

Final Tax Bills for commercial, industrial, multi-residential, and aggregate extraction tax classes are also issued with two installments – installments are due the second last business day of **August** and **November**, respectively.

The Final Tax Bill includes special charges of garbage/ water/sewer, if applicable.

Properties with a mortgage company listed on the tax account will receive a copy of the Final Tax Bill, with 'Sent to Mortgage Company for Payment' noted at the bottom.

#### **Late Payment**

Payment must be received by our office on or before the due date. A late payment penalty of 1.25% per month is added to any outstanding taxes levied on the first day of each month until paid. Payments made on your account are applied first to any outstanding penalty and then to the oldest outstanding taxes.

## **Paying Your Property Taxes**

#### **Online Banking**

This payment option is available with most major banks. Use your 19 digit roll number (without decimals or spaces) as your account number and search "Petawawa" to locate account name e.g. "Petawawa, Town of – Tax Acct."

#### **Bank/Financial Institution**

Contact your financial institution for further information. Bank service charges may apply.

#### **Bv Mail**

Send your payment to the Town of Petawawa, 1111 Victoria Street, Petawawa ON K8H 2E6. Include either the stub from your tax bill or a note with payment information.

#### In Person

The Town Office is located at 1111 Victoria Street, Petawawa and is open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday except statutory holidays. We accept payment by cash, cheque (made payable to the Town of Petawawa) or Interac.

#### **Night Deposit Box**

A night deposit box is located at the Council Chambers entrance of the Town Office. Please ensure that your cheque and payment information are placed in a sealed envelope. Please do not place cash in this box.

#### **Post-Dated Cheques**

Post-dated cheques can be dropped off at the Town Office in person, mailed or deposited in the night deposit box.

NOTE: The Town of Petawawa does not offer Preauthorized Payment Plans.

#### **Postal Strike**

Ratepayers are reminded that despite any potential postal strike, penalties will still be assessed on past due balances for property taxes, in accordance with Town by-laws.

The taxpayer remains liable for taxes and penalties, regardless of tax bill receipt.



#### 1. Legal Description of Property

Includes roll number, legal owner(s), civic address (if addressed), and details identifying the specific of parcel of land.

## 2. Mortgage Information

Details of the mortgage company, if noted on the tax account.

#### 3. Assessment and Tax Rates

Includes school board designation, assessed value provided by MPAC, and tax rates for the town, county, and education.

## 4. Special Charges, if Applicable

Garbage, water, and sewer flat rates are billed exclusively on the Final Tax Bill, and only to properties with these services.

## 5. Summary

Total taxes levied, including new tax rates and special charges. This amount, less the interim billing, is then divided into two installments.

#### 6. Installment Due Dates and Amounts

The total amount due is divided into two installments, each with a separate due date. A reminder for Second Installment is not sent.
